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Honourable Members of the CDM Executive Board,
Dear Mr. Duan,

The PD Forum would like to propose the expansion of the positive list of automatically additional projects. A positive list is an excellent tool to support projects that need additional finance in sectors where such projects co-exist with many carbon intensive technologies and practices that are economically more attractive. There are many technologies and sectors that are clearly additional and we would therefore like to kindly ask you to expand the positive list as soon as possible. Our suggestions for the expansion of the list are as follows:

Solar: In accordance with EB63 Annex 24, solar PV and solar thermal electricity up to 15MW are additional. We suggest that the cap in capacity of 15MW is not necessary and suggest that the all solar PV and solar thermal electricity projects can be deemed additional, regardless of installed capacity.

Wind: In accordance with EB63 Annex 24, off-shore wind up to 15MW is additional. Please expand automatic additionality regardless of installed capacity. Also, please expand to all wind regardless of installed capacity. While on-shore wind may become competitive in the next five years or so, it is not competitive, even in the best locations, at the moment. The inclusion can be reviewed every 3 years, as is decided for the automatic micro-scale technologies proposed by DNAs.

Geothermal Geothermal is to date not competitive, nowhere in the world. As for wind, the inclusion can be reviewed every 3 years.

Marine: In accordance with EB63 Annex 24, wave and tidal up to 15MW are additional. Also, there are many other marine technologies upcoming including those using the temperature difference between top and bottom of the ocean and the difference in salt content between sea and river water flowing into the sea. Thus, please expand automatic additionality regardless of installed capacity and sub-technology.

Household-level projects: Such projects (including cookstove and water purification, efficient light-bulbs etc.) should be automatically additional regardless of the size of the project. As each individual household or business unit is very small, the limit on the size of the project, including the small scale limit for small scale methodologies, should be waived.

May we suggest submitting this list to the 4th CDM Roundtable with the aim to have it expanded even further? Please do not hesitate to contact us in case you wish for further information.
